RE:	Public University Tuition Statement Act

The Board of Higher Education is required by the Public University Tuition Statement Act, 110 ILCS 63/10, to determine annually the average resident tuition subsidy from the State of Illinois for each undergraduate resident student and to provide such calculation to each public university. The statute outlines the formula to be used to calculate such subsidy. Attached are two tables, the first (Table 1) summarizing the individual costs included in the average costs and the tuition subsidy, and the second (Table 2) providing the supporting calculations.

Each public university is required by the Act to include as part of its undergraduate student tuition bills or other statement of tuition charges, or as a separate attachment to the bill or charge, the following statement:

For fiscal year 2023, the General Assembly and the Governor authorized the aggregate amount of \$1.22 billion to be appropriated from the General Revenue Fund and the Education Assistance Fund for operation of the State's public universities. Each resident undergraduate full-time public university student received an average tuition subsidy of **\$5,263** from the State of Illinois, which was applied to offset the full cost of instruction.

**According to GOMB, General Funds Transfers for debt service on bonds issued under GO Bond Act Section 3 does not include transfers to pay debt service on bonds that refunded bonds that were issued pursuant to Section 3 of the GO Bond Act. Higher Education Share of General Funds Debt Service does not include transfers made to pay debt service on refunding bonds that refunded bonds that were issued pursuant to authorization in section 3e of the General Obligation Bond Act, which authorizes bond proceeds to be used for higher education projects.

***The reported number only includes Public University General Funds and UIF Appropriations. It no longer includes community college appropriations.
